Alan Extreme, the Comedy Stunt Man

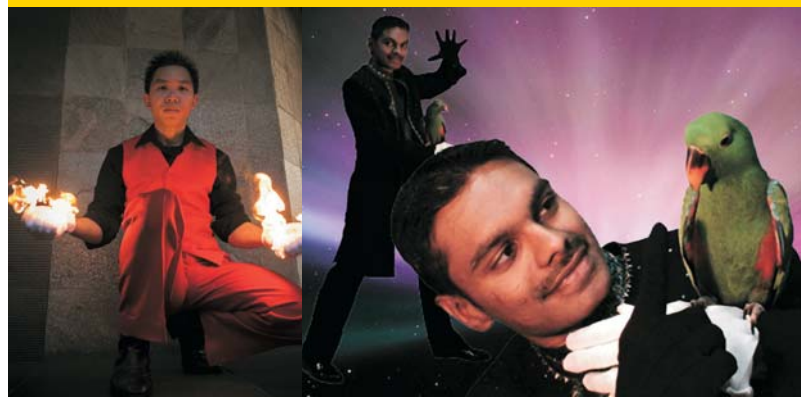

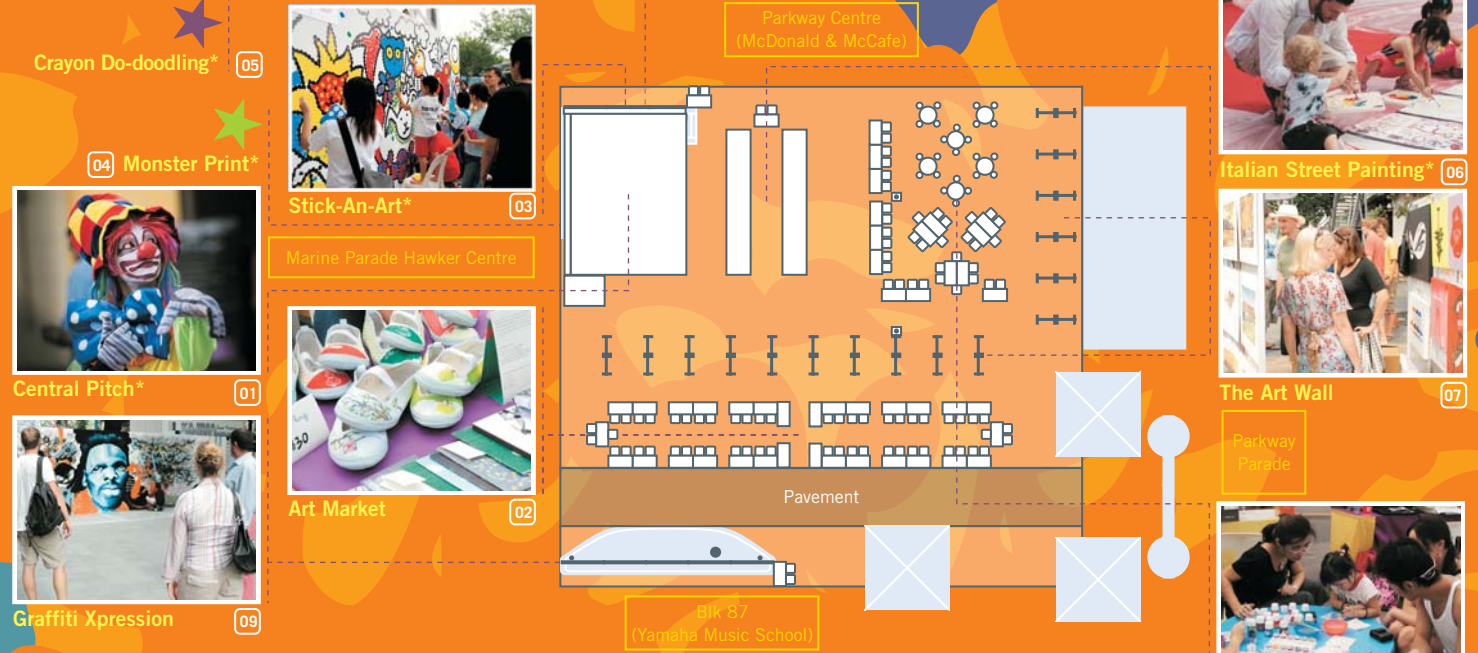
Impromptu Live Demonstration & Hands-on Session

60 meters of Visual Art Exhibition

Since its inaugural year in 2006, the ArtsStreet Art Wall has doubled its length to reach 60m and really needs no formal introduction. Then, there is full-time feline artist **Ng Ling Tze**, Shanghainese Gongbi influenced **Min Eng Fern**, multicultural artist **Rajinder Singh** and **Irene Hong**, a water colour artist who is no stranger to local art publications.
